*NOTE: All children booked in on excursion days must go on the excursion. If circumstances beyond our control cause a change to, or cancellation of, an excursion we will give families as much notice of this as possible. Please make sure your child is wearing enclosed shoes and has warm clothes for outdoor play.*

## Booking into Holiday Care

The completed Booking Request and Excursion Permission forms for the July Holidays should be emailed to [oshc@ccc.tas.gov.au](mailto:oshc@ccc.tas.gov.au) before Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup>. Please complete one set of forms per child. If you have not used Holiday Care with us before you will also need to complete the Enrolment form available on our website.

Places are allocated in the order that completed forms are received. This includes any medical forms required. Days may be fully booked prior to the closure of bookings. We will set up waitlists for days once we reach our capacity.

Parents and emergency contacts will be provided with a PIN to use when signing children in and out of care on the devices at the services. This can be set to the same number you use for ASC or BSC services.

On excursion days all children booked in for that day must go on the excursion. Details of the excursion are on the Excursion Permission form attached to the Booking request form.

## Fees/Cancellations/Absences

The fee for a day of Holiday Care is \$78.50 less your Child Care Subsidy (CCS). There is no additional charge for excursions. If you are claiming CCS this must be arranged prior to the start of holidays with Centrelink. A CCS enrolment will be generated as part of the booking process once days are confirmed and can be confirmed in your MyGov to bring through your CCS eligibility. Invoices are emailed and payment of fees can be made by BPAY (details on your invoice), direct debit from credit card or by cash or card at the Clarence City Council offices in Rosny Park.

If your child is not attending Holiday Care on a booked day please let us know by email at [oshc@ccc.tas.gov.au](mailto:oshc@ccc.tas.gov.au) or call on **62179610**.

Notified absences will be charged a fee of \$40 (less your CCS). If we can fill the place, there will be no charge. Absences without notification will be charged \$50 (less your CCS). A late collection fee of \$35 is charged for every 15 minutes after 6pm per child per day.

## Medical Conditions and additional support needs

If your child has a medical condition or additional needs such as dietary requirements, we need this documented on our Medical Management and Communication Plan. A Medical Action Plan, Authority to Administer Medication and a Medication log may also be required

depending on the condition. Care will not be confirmed unless we have all forms. Blank forms are available on our website.

Only medication with the pharmacist's dispensing label stating the child's name, medication name, dosage and expiry date will be accepted and administered. This applies to over the counter medication such as antihistamines.

If you have medication stored at your ASC/BSC service, please collect it on your last day of care before the holidays and deliver to Holiday Care with your child. Care will not be provided unless we have the medication.

## Excursions

On excursion days we would appreciate all children arriving by 8.30am to allow us time to get ready for the excursion. Information about the excursions is on the Excursion Permission form attached to the booking form. All excursions are Risk Assessed, and these are available on request at the service.

## Food

Please ensure your child has morning and afternoon tea, a nutritious lunch and snacks for the day. Fresh fruit is provided for the children by the service. All children should also have a refillable water bottle. Water is available throughout the day.

## Sun protection and clothing

Children should be dressed in suitable clothing and footwear that is appropriate for the weather conditions and a day of active indoor/outdoor play. For the July holidays warm layers, coats and beanies are recommended! In accordance with our Suncare policy sunhats are not required this holiday.

## Bikes and Scooters

Bikes and scooters can be brought to care provided children also have appropriate safety gear – helmets and wrist guards. Bikes and scooters are brought at your own risk.

## Phones, smart watches and other devices

Phones, smart watches and any other devices that can connect to the internet are not permitted in Holiday Care. If these are found, we will store them safely until parents come at the end of the day. If you need to get a message to your child, please call the service phone or leave a message at our office.

## Changes to the program

Clarence Children's Services reserves the right to cancel or change excursions and in-house activities when circumstances such as weather conditions, venue cancellations or other circumstances beyond our control indicate this is necessary. If a change is made, we will endeavour to notify families as soon as is possible.
